Dear Craftspeople,

The **30<sup>th</sup> Annual Alexandria Church Fair** is scheduled for **Saturday, August 9, 2008**. This is your invitation to participate.

The cost to participants is **\$25 per vendor space**. This fee includes a ticket (\$7 value) to our Annual Chicken BBQ served in the Old Town Hall, across the road from the church, at 5 pm, on the day of the fair. All of you are welcome to stay and join us for supper. All proceeds from the Fair will be used for the important work of our Church.

We urge you to register early, as space is limited. Previous participants who sign up by **July 9<sup>th</sup>** will have priority. After that date, spaces will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

Fair setup begins at 7:00 AM, with the opening at 9:00 AM. The Fair continues through the barbeque at 5:00 PM. We ask craftspeople to remain until at least 4:00 PM.

Ongoing activities include a white elephant tent, a book sale in the sanctuary, petting zoo for the kids under the pines, and craft demonstrations. There will be a Bake Sale in the Vestry. The Ladies Group hosts a Craft Sale Tent. There is a food tent that serves lunch from 10 am until 2 pm. We wrap up with a chicken barbecue at 5 pm.

Our Master of Ceremonies is our very own Reverend John Fischer.
